



# Zechariah 11:1-17

## 'Rejection'

# 1. Verses 1-3 – The Approaching Storm

An approaching storm from the north which will flatten and devastate everything in its path.

Figurative language for the arrival of the armies of Rome.

## 2. Verses 4-11... God's rejection of Israel.

The nation of Israel has persistently rejected God and refused to repent...

God will now reject them.

If you do the same, God will reject you

Note:

v6 – the 'king' is the Emperor of Rome who will eventually destroy them...

"we have no king but Caesar" – John 19:15

### 3. Verses 12-14, Israel's rejection of God.

Israel's evaluation of God is 30 pieces of silver... that of a dead slave. Ex 21:32
