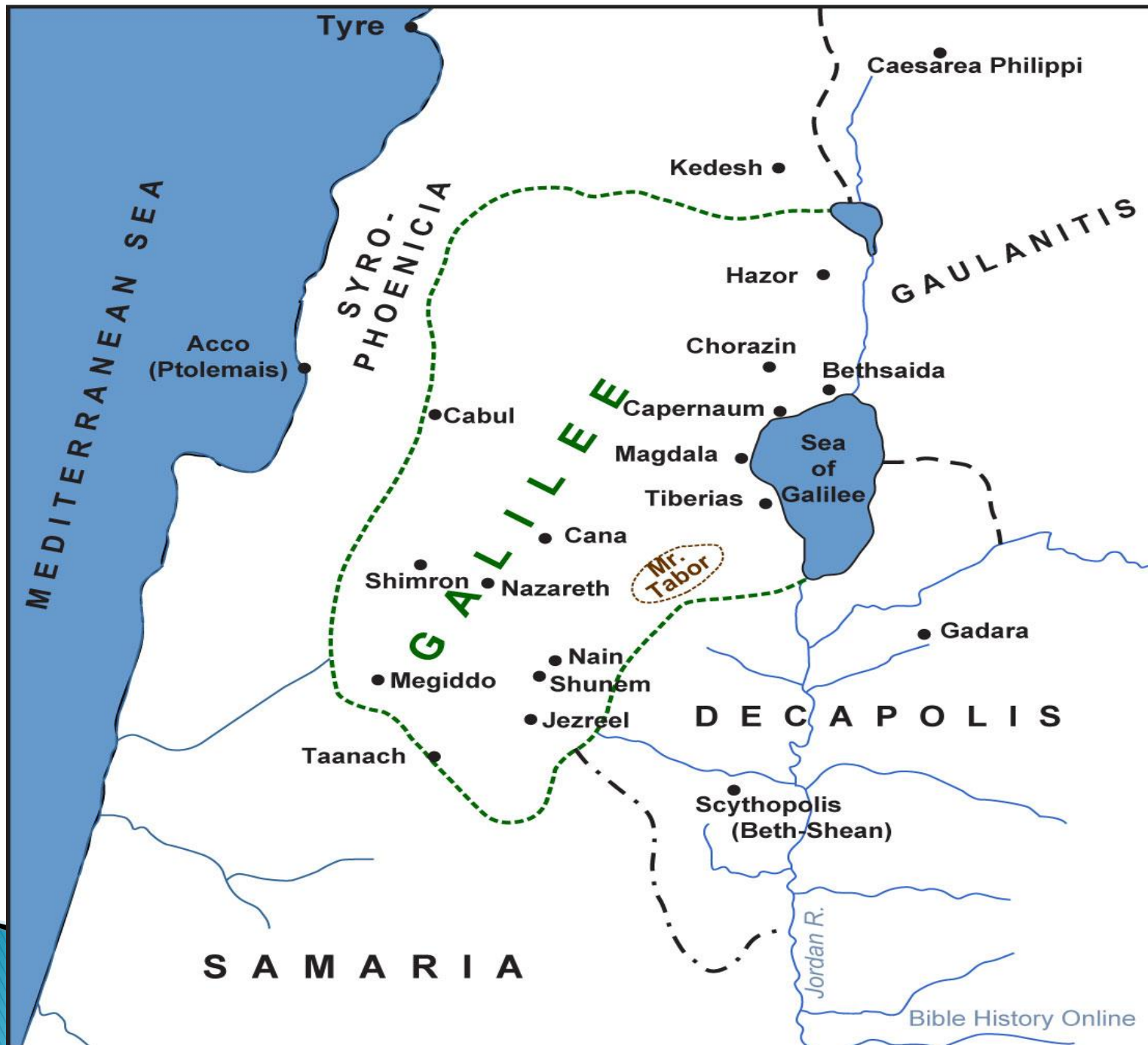


Luke 7:1–10

1. The Jewish elders...

“this man is worthy of Christ’s compassion”

That’s exactly how many people think today.

should look upon them favourably.

“They’re not a bad person & I’m not a bad

2. The Centurion...

“I am not worthy of anything from Christ”

John 6:35


“I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.”

John 11:25

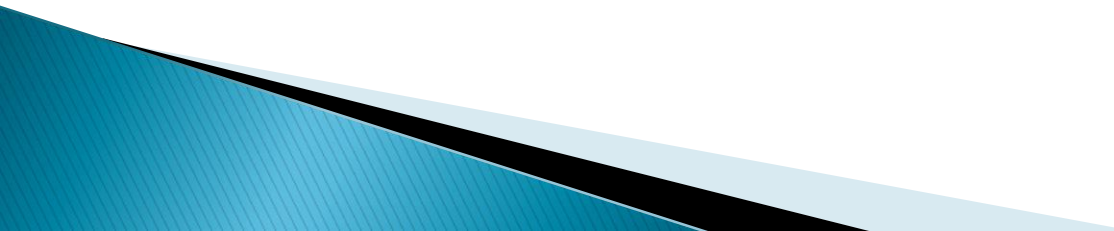
“I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.
