# 1. What does it say?

- o Is 55 Verse 1 :*
- o Ho! (Listen) Everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; And you who have no money, Come, buy and eat! Yes, come, buy wine and milk, without money, and without price.*

- o Yes, come, buy wine and milk, without money, and without price.*

## 2. Who is it from?

- o The Lord Jesus Christ! (v:1-2)
- o In Isaiah 53 we see the things that would happen to the Lord Jesus
- o ..despised, rejected, suffered...
- o That He took our sin upon Himself
- o That He was pierced for our transgressions, and bruised for our iniquities....

## 2. Who is it from?

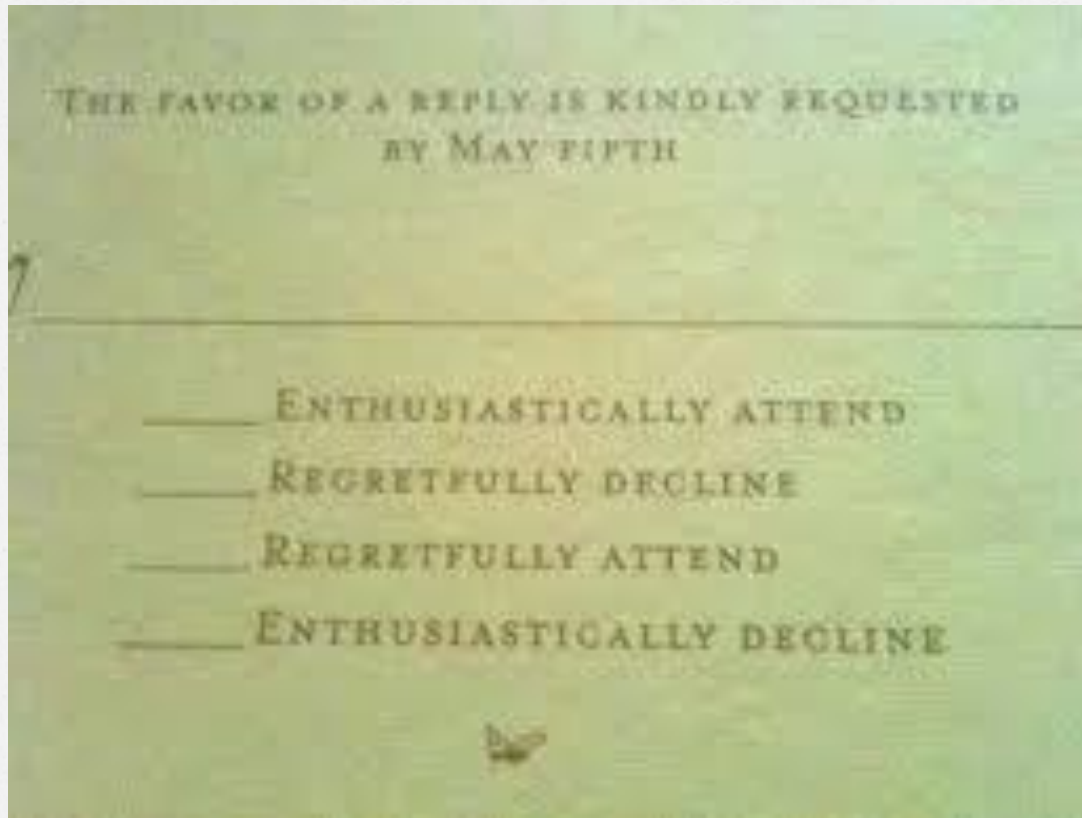
- o **The Lord Jesus Christ! (v:1-2)**
- o The water – which quenches (John 4:13)
- o The milk – which nourishes (1 Peter 2:2)
- o The bread – which feeds us (John 6:48)
- o The wine – which gladdens (John 2)

### 3. Who is it to?

- o “All who are thirsty”
- o “All who are hungry”
- o “Come, buy without money....”
  
- o Isaiah 45:22 *“Look to Me and be saved, all you ends of the earth! For I am God and there is no other”*
- o Ezekiel 18:23 *“Do I have any pleasure that the wicked should die?... And not that he should turn from his ways and live!”*

### o Verse 6-7

- o Seek the Lord, while He may be found
- o Call upon Him while He is near
- o Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts, and let him return to the Lord..
- o And He will have mercy on him
- o And to our God, and He will abundantly pardon
