




The Message sent to Jesus

- ▶ “This sickness is not unto death” (4)
 - ▶ “But for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified through it.” (4)
 - ▶ The concern of the disciples (7–11)
 - ▶ Why did Jesus defer his visit?
 - ▶ Did he really love Lazarus?
 - ▶ Is there really an explanation?

The Meeting Jesus had

- ▶ Why did Jesus stay? (4, 40)
 - ▶ Jesus states the case “Lazarus is dead” (12–14)
 - ▶ Many Jews joined Mary & Martha (19)
 - ▶ The complaint of Martha (21)
 - ▶ Martha’s declaration of faith (22)
 - ▶ The assurance Jesus gives (23,24)
 - ▶ The declaration of Jesus; “I am the resurrection and The Life” (25, 26)
 - ▶ Martha’s response & reaction (27–32)

The Miracle that took place

- ▶ The request of Jesus when he saw Mary crying “Where have you laid him” (33–37)
 - ▶ The Love of Jesus for Lazarus, Jesus wept (35)
 - ▶ The questioning of some; (37)
 - ▶ The stone is rolled away (38)
 - ▶ The concern of the sisters “There is a stench” (39)
 - ▶ The Shout of Jesus; “Lazarus come out” (43–44)

The Meaning and effect of this Miracle should have upon us?

- ▶ It caused many Jews to believe (45)
 - ▶ It caused many to turn against him (46)
 - ▶ It caused The Pharisee's plot against him (47–48)
 - ▶ It resulted in Caiaphas the High Priest stating one man should die for the whole nation (51–52)
 - ▶ It closes with them plotting to put Jesus to death (53–54)
